SAFELY DISPOSE OF YOUR EXPIRED OR UNUSED PRESCRIPTION DRUGS

Mail back your pharmaceuticals by picking up a "return label" at your local pharmacy, or use the Bennington County Sheriffs Department address below.

Do:

1. Find a mailer that is water-resistant and tear-proof.
2. Keep pharmaceuticals in their original containers. Mark out your name if desired.
3. Wrap liquids in a paper towel and put in a sealed plastic bag before placing inside the envelope.
4. Seal the envelope carefully and securely.
5. Place the label on the envelope.
6. Place appropriate postage on the envelope and drop it in the mailbox.

Don't:

1. Mail syringes
2. Overfill the envelope

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
